

Regent's Graduate Honor Award

The Regents' Honor Awards are among the highest recognitions of accomplishment that the University bestows on its graduate students. The awards are presented in the Spring Term to the year's best master's and doctoral degree recipients in each college.

Degree-candidates and recent graduates with a cumulative GPA over 3.8 are invited by the Dean of Graduate Studies to apply for the Regents Award in February. Their applications are received and reviewed by college faculty committees. The best master's and doctoral candidates/recipients are nominated for their exceptional accomplishments in coursework, professional training, and capstone projects; scholarly productivity; academic/professional positions and honors; community outreach, and placement or promotion. The nominations are sent to the Dean of Graduate Studies in March.

The Regents' Graduate Honor Awardees are announced to the university community at the Research and Creativity Symposium which is held at the end of the Spring Term.
