The 2023 Annual Report for the M.Arch. program at University of Hartford was reviewed during the April 26-27, 2024, meeting of the Board of Directors of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB).

Based on the review of the Annual Report, the NAAB directors voted to accept the Annual Report and require a Special Report to address the following areas:

Condition 6.6: Student Financial Information

The program must demonstrate that students have access to an initial estimate for all tuition, fees, books, general supplies, and specialized materials that may be required during the full course of study for completing the NAAB-accredited degree program. The link provided has information on the tuition and fee schedule but does not provide prospective M.Arch. students with a full estimate of the cost of attendance that includes the costs of books, general supplies, and specialized materials required to complete the degree.

The program must provide a narrative and supporting evidence to demonstrate compliance with these Conditions. The Special Report is due no later than **June 30, 2024.**
